STRENGTHS

- Low prevalence of diabetes among women
- Low percentage of low-risk cesarean deliveries
- Low prevalence of tobacco use among adolescents

CHALLENGES

- Low prevalence of women with a dedicated health care provider
- Low percentage of prenatal care before third trimester
- Low prevalence of supportive neighborhoods

HIGHLIGHTS

- In the past year, HPV immunization among females ages 13-17 increased 24% from 46.6% to 57.9%
- In the past year, HPV immunization among males ages 13-17 increased 16% from 41.7% to 48.4%
- In the past year, substance use disorder among youth decreased 14% from 5.6% to 4.8%
- In the past three years, flu vaccination among women ages 18-44 increased 16% from 25.3% to 29.4%
- In the past three years, tobacco use among youth ages 12-17 decreased 47% from 6.8% to 3.6%
- In the past three years, teen suicide increased 25% from 10.4 to 13.0 deaths per 100,000 adolescents ages 15-19












Percentage of women ages 18-44 who reported binge drinking (four or more drinks on one occasion in the past 30 days) or heavy drinking (eight or more drinks per week)









Age-adjusted number of deaths due to drug injury (unintentional, suicide, homicide or undetermined) per 100,000 females ages 15-44






Infant Mortality


