- High percentage of households with highspeed internet
- High prevalence of exercise

CHALLENGES

- High suicide rate
- Low prevalence of cancer screenings
- Low flu vaccination coverage

HIGHLIGHTS

- Food insecurity decreased 34% between 2015-16 and 2017-18 from 18.9% to 12.5% of adults ages 60+
- Flu vaccination coverage increased 16% between 2015 and 2019 from 52.6% to 60.9% of adults ages 65+
- Multiple chronic conditions increased 11% between 2014 and 2018 from 33.0% to 36.5% of Medicare beneficiaries ages 65+





Flu Vaccination - Ages 65+




Percentage of adults ages 65 and older who reported receiving a seasonal flu vaccine in the past 12 months









Preventable Hospitalizations - Ages 65-74







Frequent Mental Distress - Ages 65+




Percentage of adults ages 65 and older who reported their mental health was not good 14 or more days in the past 30 days






